NOTE 1: The FY25 House bill consolidates the National Institute on Minority Health and Health Disparities and the National Institute of Nursing Research with three other institutes under a new institute called "National Institute on Health Sciences Research." The bill provides \$1.9 billion total for the five institutes grouped together, but does not specify each institutes portion of that total.

NOTE 2: The FY25 House bill increases the CDC Division of Cancer Prevention and Control programs by \$7 million, but that increase was not specifically attributed to each program. The programs are allocated no less than FY24 enacted funding, with the exception of the Breast and Cervical Cancer programs receiving no less than \$237.5 million, Ovarian Cancer programs receiving no less than \$15.5 million, and Johanna's Law receiving no less than \$12 million.

NOTE 3: Amount does not include the Wisewoman heart disease program, which is housed within the breast and cervical cancer program. Within the program's total, OVAC requests at least \$230 million for non-Wisewoman activities.
